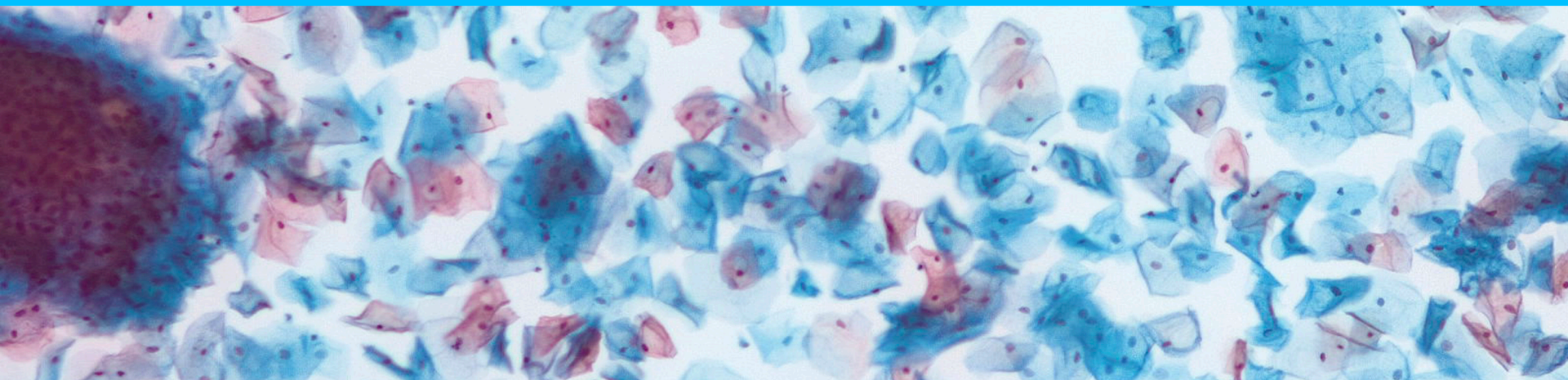




POST BACCALAUREATE CERTIFICATE IN CYTOTECHNOLOGY

The Cytotechnologist is the health professional responsible for the evaluation and interpretation of cytological samples for the detection and differentiation of tumour cells. In this way, it is a fundamental part in the early detection, diagnosis and treatment of cancer.

The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Cytotechnology lasts for twelve months (two semesters and summer). It is the only academic program in Puerto Rico and is accredited by the “**Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs**”. <http://eps.rcm.upr.edu/cythotechnology/>

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Hold a bachelor’s degree in science or arts from an accredited university or college.
- 2) Have a minimum general academic index of 2.50.
- 3) Have a minimum specific academic index of 2.50 in required courses*.
- 4) Satisfactorily pass the following courses or their equivalents at an accredited university:

Mathematics	6
Physics (CIFI is not accepted)	8
Chemistry	8
Biology (CIBI is not accepted)	20

Total: 42 Credits
