

PRECEPTOR SELECTION GUIDELINES

The preceptor directly supervises students while they are in a practice site.

In order to qualify for the position, the preceptor must:

- Be a pharmacist licensed to practice in Puerto Rico or in any state of the United States of America authorized by the corresponding Board of Pharmacy.
- 2. Be a member of the Puerto Rico Pharmacists Association or corresponding professional organization.
- 3. Hold license re-certification by complying with continuing education requirements.
- 4. Have at least two years of experience as a licensed pharmacist.
- 5. Demonstrate competence in activities related to the job.
- 6. Demonstrate willingness to assume the responsibilities of the preceptorship as stated in the document of preceptor responsibilities.
- 7. Have approval of the preceptorship by the supervisor and employer.
- 8. Participate in professional and community activities.
- 9. Be a role model of professional and ethical conduct.
- 10. Be receptive to new ideas.
- 11. Demonstrate effective communication skills.
- 12. Have good professional relations with other members of the health team in his/her community.
